It transits the unwieldy space between journey and creation with the smoothness of a cat burglar intruding on us when least expected.

SILVER WAS THE SWAN - NO BLUE, SHE SAID is the gleaming streets and buildings of a decadent old lady seen at night from the cinematic distance of an airplane, or the closeness of cold scaffolding covering the pastel fires of an old world. in this sacred domain a unique intimacy with things take place. all surroundings are dispelled by a powerful attraction that propels us into objects; we enter a bewitched zone where moments and places navigate alongside one another on a slow motion carousel whose horses shift with each rise and fall.
